□ <b>D</b> e-escalation
<ul> <li>Current vital signs frequency. Can it be reduced?</li> <li>Current lab orders. Can they be discontinued or frequency reduced?</li> <li>Current telemetry orders. Can it be discontinued?</li> </ul>
Status: Code status. Goals of care discussion indicated?
$\square$ <b>P</b> rophylaxis: Are they on chemical DVT prophylaxs? If not, why not?
Indication for admission: What is keeping them from de-escalating level of care or going home?
☐ <b>Transition</b> : What barriers to safe discharge exist? (e.g. is there a good plan for where they will go after the hospital)
