

## COVID ROUNDING: COF AND SPIT

- C**COVID status: (Confirmed, Under Investigation, Ruled out). Symptom day #
- O**xygen requirement: How much. When it was last required?
- F**ever: Time of last fever, antipyretic use.
  
- A**ntibiotics: Agents used, day \_\_ of \_\_ (if applicable)
- N**ovel Medications
  - Hydroxychloroquine dose # of 10 (if applicable)
  - Study drug day \_\_ of \_\_ (if applicable)
- D**e-escalation
  - Current vital signs frequency. Can it be reduced?
  - Current lab orders. Can they be discontinued or frequency reduced?
  - Current telemetry orders. Can it be discontinued?
  
- S**tatus: Code status. Goals of care discussion indicated?
- P**rophylaxis: Are they on chemical DVT prophylaxis? If not, why not?
- I**ndication for admission: What is keeping them from de-escalating level of care or going home?
- T**ransition: What barriers to safe discharge exist? (e.g. is there a good plan for where they will go after the hospital)
